

Riverfest is a free fun family event that attracts some 4,500 local people – your charity needs to be there! The annual Riverfest celebrates the heritage, community, businesses and wildlife associated with the historic Medina River. It is organised by Newport Carnival & Community Events Association (NCCEA), who for over 100 years have organised many events in and around Newport.

The event aims to achieve the following;

- To raise awareness of the water environment and in particular the River Medina
- To encourage community involvement
- To promote sustainable transport
- To support local organisations and businesses

This year's event is being supported by Newport & Carisbrooke Community Council. The Quay is used thanks to kind permission of the Isle of Wight Council. The event will be promoted through the local press, on our websites, social media, posters and banners.

Businesses are asked to make a donation of between £50 and £400, this will pay for your IW Council's Street Traders Licence for this event, and to support the work of our committee. **You must also fill in the attached IWC form and return it to us, if you are selling anything. We must have this by the 10th April, at the latest.**

The Isle of Wight Council states that all traders must have 10-million-pound public liability insurance if you are trading on council grounds.

We do not recommend the use of gazebos on the site; however, it is down to the individual business or charity if you/they decide to erect one, NCCEA will not be held accountable for any incidents, accidents or injury. Generators are permitted on site but please inform us in advance. Arrangements maybe able to be put in place to supply power. This must be arranged in advance. No balloon releases. No lanterns.
